2. The membership fee is payable after invoicing for the current calendar year within 30 days of receipt of the invoice. When joining from the July 1 of the current year, the membership fee is reduced by 50 percent.
3. In individual cases, the Board of Directors may decide to defer, reduce or waive the annual membership fee for the individual year upon written application of the respective member with a two-thirds majority. This cannot be decided for several years at the same time. The General Assembly shall be informed of such decisions.
4. Members and non-members may make special contributions at any time regardless of their membership dues.
5. Amendments to the Rules of Contribution must be adopted by the General Meeting with at least 75 percent of the votes cast and communicated to all members at least three months before the beginning of the fiscal year for which the amended Rules of Contribution are to apply for the first time.
6. Individual companies may be granted free membership in the first year of their membership as part of special measures. The Executive Board decides on the measures that may include this offer and informs the members at the next General Meeting.
